Castleton YHA and the adjacent Vicarage are located in the centre of Castleton, and sits at the base of Peveril Castle. It is within walking distance of the four Caverns: Blue John Cavern, Peak Cavern, Treak Cliff Cavern and Speedwell Cavern.

Approach:

The YHA in Castleton is adjacent to the Vicarage which accessed via The Market Place.

Vicarage Approach

A Stone Flag path leads to the entrance of the Vicarage. The main door is wide enough for a wheelchair user, and the hall can also accommodate a wheelchair user.

Accommodation

- Large spacious en-suite rooms of 1-5 in the Vicarage. There are two level access rooms, which have showers, but each has a step up into the shower cubicle. Not suitable for unassisted wheelchair users.
- Large spacious Lounge with comfortable furniture

YHA Main Building

Approach:

A Stone Flag path leads to the entrance of the YHA. The main door is accessible.

Accommodation:

- The ground floor rooms are accessible
- There is accessible accommodation in the Barn. Although, there are showers, these are not suitable for an independent Wheelchair user, as they are accessed via a steep step.
- Accessible toilets
- Games Room
- Three Lounges
- Lounge for group leaders
- Small Library
- Multi-purpose work rooms
- Table Licence
- Hearing Loop
- There is a designated car parking bay at the back of the YHA.
