The Ladybower Inn is a Free House, and is situated on the A57 Sheffield to Manchester road, and overlooks the Ladybower Reservoir. All bedrooms have colour TV and tea making facilities.

Approach:

The Car Park contains loose gravel. There is ample car-parking, but not the provision of a designated parking bay.

Accommodation:

There are three long flat steps at different heights followed by a Lipsill into the Inn. No handrails have been provided. There is a side entrance which can be used on request. However, there is not an internal accessible toilet and the toilet facilities are not accessible to a wheelchair user. There are three accessible bedrooms on ground level adjacent to the entrance to the Inn.

The first accessible room has a ramp, but no handrails have been provided. The entrance door is 700 mm, and thus is not wide enough to accommodate a wheelchair user. There is an excellent wet room facility.

The second bedroom is accessed by one large flat deep flag, which is not level. A handrail is provided. Shower room, small step into the shower.

The third bedroom is accessed by two steps, one flag, and a shorter steeper step. A handrail is provided.
