The Yorkshire Bridge Inn is situated in a glorious location, almost on the shores of Laybower Reservoir in Derbyshire's lovely Hope Valley. Bamford is at the heart of the UK's National Peak Park District. This stunning location and superb accommodation is convenient for Chatsworth and Peak District attractions.

Approach:

There are 2-3 designated parking bays outside the accommodation, and there is also designated accessible off-road parking.

Accommodation

There are twelve en-suite accessible bedrooms at The Yorkshire Bridge Inn. Most have traditional en-suite bathrooms, but there are a few rooms with showers. The accommodation is split into two levels.

On the first floor, there are four steps to the bar area – a rope handrail is provided.

On the lower ground floor – all the bedroom's internal doors lead outside

Interior General

Public passageways that lead to the rooms and facilities are not particularly wide, and thus assistance would be required for wheelchair users. On the first floor there are four steps to the bar and dining area – a rope handrail is provided.
